Understanding Glue Ear – For Parents

- Have you noticed your child isn't responding to you and are worried about their hearing?
- Are they struggling to concentrate and attend?
- Are you concerned about their speech and language development?

Glue ear is very common– 1 in 5 pre-school children have glue ear at any one time and 8 out of 10 children will experience glue ear before the age of 10.
