Dear Parents & Carer,

Firstly, I would like to say a huge thank you to everyone who helped to organise and who came to our Summer Fair last Saturday. It was an enormous success and a very joyful event! This week our Y6 children have been on their residential trip to Gilwell Park. I visited them on Wednesday and they were really enjoying themselves! It is a wonderful experience - one which they will remember for the rest of their lives. We had some good news this week from the local authority - we are going to have the playground surface in the Early Years playground redone to get rid of the tree root trip hazards and also the KS2 toilets are going to be upgraded. Next week we begin our transition activities for the children. These will be carried out over the next 3 weeks. Children who we know to be particularly anxious about transition will be told in the morning on Monday and spend time with their teaching assistants preparing them for the transition before the rest of the class are told - so that they are not surprised when the class is told.
