The Blue & Green Spring Clean Saturday 12th of March to Sunday 20th of March

Waltham Forest Council is planning its 10th Annual Spring Clean and would like to invite our community groups to organise an event.

In previous year's thousands of local residents, along with schools, faith groups and local businesses have come together to litter pick, spruce up 'unloved' spaces, paint areas and plant flowers and shrubs, in their local neighbourhoods, in a huge demonstration of civic pride.

If you would like to arrange an event please let us know the time, day, location and number of volunteers and pupils taking part, and Waltham Forest Council will help supply the equipment you need and help you to promote it in your local neighbourhood! To participate, simply complete the 'The Blue & Spring Clean Equipment Request' form and email it back to Greenspace.volunteers@walthamforest.gov.uk by Monday 7th of March, so that we can make arrangements for you to receive the equipment you need and help promote your event.

This year we have added 'Blue' into the event title, highlighting the importance of our water courses, water bodies, and water-based wildlife. There are several watercourses running through the Borough with a combined length of 44 kilometres, the main ones being the River Lea and Dagenham Brook, that go down the Western side and the River Ching that goes from East to West in the Northern part of the Borough.

The main water bodies are the Chingford Reservoirs and the Walthamstow reservoirs, also known as the Walthamstow Wetlands, which is the largest urban wetland nature reserve in Europe, and supplies water to 3.5 million people.

There are several river clean events already taking place over the weekends of the 12th and 19th and if you would like to participate then please contact <u>Greenspace.volunteers@walthamforest.gov.uk</u> and we'll put you in touch with the relevant organisers.
