From Monday we welcome Jennifer Tatnall (one of our parents) who is a music teacher. She will be teaching children and training staff every Monday this year and supporting us in embedding music and performance into our curriculum. We are all very excited especially for performances!!

Asthma Pumps / EPI PEN

Mobile Phones

Appointments

Parents and carers are asked most earnestly **not** to arrange these during school sessions, except in cases of urgency, so that considerable interference with school work is avoided. Please do not keep children out of school for the whole day unless absolutely necessary.
