Dear Parents & Carer,

Individual children who need more time or find change difficult will be told prior to the whole class finding out so that they are not surprised or anxious. They will then have plenty of opportunities between 4th and 21st July to get to know their new classroom teacher and playgrounds etc. All of these strategies are part of our transition planning for the children to try and alleviate as much anxiety as possible for the children.

There have been several incidents happen in the park after school hours and we are having to deal with them in school when children come in the next day angry, upset or confused. Playtime altercations, too, seem to be rising slightly. We are therefore doing lots of work with the children about playing nicely together, sharing, turn-taking and speaking nicely to each other. This all highlights how much some children have missed during the pandemic through not being able to interact widely with lots of other children on a daily basis and what we are finding is supported by recent research across the country. As staff we know that we need to scaffold and model the behaviours and skills we want our children to learn as they grow. It will take a while but they will soon get back what they have lost. This is why events like the Summer Fair are so important - they bring us all back together again!
