HAPPY VEGAN-UARY!

The New Year is a great time to switch it up and try something different. Why not give these Crispy Cauliflower Nuggets a go as a healthy alternative to traditional chicken nuggets or turkey dinosaurs—oh, and did we mention they're vegan?!

CAULIFLOWER NÜGGETS

Ingredients:

- •450g cauliflower florets (one medium head)
- 4 tablespoons vegan mayonnaise (or regular/light mayo- it just won't be vegan then!)
- •60g breadcrumbs
- •1 teaspoon onion powder
- •1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- •1/2 teaspoon ground paprika
- •Salt & pepper to taste
- •2 tablespoon ketchup
- •2 tablespoon vegan mayonnaise
- •1 tablespoon sriracha (optional)

What to do:

mix well.

- Preheat oven to 200°C. Line baking sheet with parchment paper or foil and set aside.
 In a large bowl, toss the cauliflower florets with the mayonnaise until completely coated and set aside.
 In a small bowl, combine breadcrumbs, onion powder, garlic powder, paprika and
- 4. Coat the cauliflower florets in the breadcrumb mixture and place on a baking
- 5. Bake for 30 minutes, turning halfway.
- 6. For the dipping sauce, combine ketchup, mayonnaise and sriracha in a small bowl.
- 7. Serve with a side of your favourite veggies and enjoy!
