This year, children will come to school wearing their pyjamas and parents are invited into school for a Reading Morning in their child's classroom.





Dear Parent/Carer,

To celebrate and encourage a lifelong love of reading at home and school, we will be running a sponsored read between Monday 4th March 2024 and Sunday 10th March 2024.

The project is being organised in conjunction with our local Independent Usborne Partner, Jessica, and all the money raised will go towards brand new books for our school.



Healthy eating, height- weight management sleep routine, hygiene, toileting hearing and vision, child development


